If you're running a commercial recreational business, conducting professional research, engaging in sand, grave, rock mining, or seafood processing, you'll need a permit to make sure your operations align with the region's values. It's all about responsible resource use that supports local growth while keeping things green and sustainable. Permit applications and information can be found on the Borough's website. The Borough encourages everyone to apply!

Let the Adventures Begin: Commercial Recreation and Research Permits. For those looking to guide people through the wild, this one is for you! Whether you're leading a fishing trip, guiding eco-tours, or running a cozy lodge, AEB's commercial recreation permits help make sure your business thrives while respecting the environment. From hunting to bird watching, if you're offering services for outdoor adventure, you need a permit! The AEB requires permits for professional research which applies to anyone conducting research if your project might impact the land. So, if you're a researcher planning to explore the region, don't forget to submit a permit application. But don't worry! School projects or cultural surveys by native corporations and tribes are exempt.

Digging into opportunity with care through **Mining**. For adventurers who want to dig a little deeper, the Aleutians East Borough has you covered with mining permits! If you're interested in *mineral or coal exploration, or small mining operations*, make sure to submit a permit application. Small mining operations (less than five acres) or larger-scale digs (five acres or more) are subject to different regulations, ensuring responsible extraction. If you're planning on doing a little more recreational panning or light prospecting, you're in luck, no permit is needed unless you're doing business out of it. But if your operations grow, don't forget to apply for the right permit to keep things on track.

Catch and Process Responsibly: **Seafood Processing Permits.** Ahoy, seafood enthusiasts! Whether you're an offshore processor working at sea or a local fisherman marketing your own catch, the Aleutians East Borough has special permits for all things seafood. The goal is to keep things sustainable and ensure the Borough's fisheries thrive while offering local

economic benefits. *Onshore Seafood Processing* ensures that all operations, whether you're handling salmon, cod, or any other local catch, meet environmental standards. It plays a critical role in the region's economy by adding value to local fishery resources and supporting the livelihoods of fishermen. The permit is required for businesses that buy, process, and export fishery resources.

Digging into **Sand**, **Gravel**, **or Rock?** Then the *Sand*, *Gravel and Rock Mining Permit* is your golden ticket to ensure your project is done right! This permit keeps your operation on track with local rules and environmental standards, making sure you're mining responsibly and minimizing the impact on the beautiful landscape in the region.
